Commonwealth Child Safe Framework

The Office of National Intelligence (ONI) remains committed to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of children and young people. We continue to implement the Commonwealth Child Safe Framework (the Framework) and consistently seek to improve child safe culture across our workforce through robust policy, transparent processes and staff training.

ONI has undertaken its annual risk assessment, and our child safety risk rating remains at 'low' as we rarely have any direct interaction with children.

Occasions where ONI may work with or engage directly or indirectly with children in the future – for example careers days and recruitment outreach activities – will require an activity specific risk assessment identifying any activity specific risks, controls and treatment strategies associated with working or engaging with children.

ONI has established a central system to ensure compliance and provide training to ensure our workforce are aware of and compliant with the Framework, which includes keeping a record of who has a current Working with Vulnerable People card, complaints, concerns and/or incidents in relation to child safety.
